### **Meeting Notes**

#### **San Juan Presentation**

San Juan is compiling Google Expedition Kits that will be lent out to sites for student use. Kits come with some instructional content, and teachers can supplement with their own. Students also have the ability to create their own expeditions. The kits have provided the opportunity to bring more content to students in the classroom, while making it easier to see and understand. Big thing for the district now is how to get the word out. Teachers need to be trained, or there is the possibility for the team to go out and guide expedition themselves.

Some of the tools needed are Google Tour Creator (which works with Google Slides and Google Draw), 180- or 360-degree photos, Chromebook or laptop and Phone or tablet running Android operating system. Unfortunately, expeditions cannot be built on iPhones. San Juan has also found that you cannot run the expeditions on school WIFI, so it is recommended to setup another router specifically for expeditions.

San Juan strongly encourages getting families' written permission Tour Creator is not in the CSDPA.

The cost for San Juan has been about \$8,000 for 12 kits. Expeditions is an app so electronics will need to be able to download apps.
